ST. CHARLES – Benchmark Construction continues to work on First Street between Indiana and Illinois streets. They successfully have passed the initial testing requirements for the new water main.

Final testing results were not provided Saturday, so water service transfers did not occur Monday. It is expected that water service transfers will occur today.

After the service transfers are complete, work on sanitary sewer and electric duct will commence and are expected to be complete to the intersection of Illinois and First streets by the middle of the week.

Restoration of the First Street and Indiana Street intersection will continue and is expected to be completed by Friday.

The First and Illinois intersection will be closed starting Wednesday for two to three weeks, contingent on successful water service transfers and weather. This will include closure of the Illinois Street Bridge to through traffic as a water main and sanitary sewer are installed across the intersection and the pavement is restored.

Once work is completed, the intersection and bridge will be opened to through traffic.

Some water main work might start north of the intersection of First and Illinois while the intersection is closed.
