Work makes its way to First, Illinois

Bartlett-based Benchmark Construction is now working on the intersection of First and Illinois streets in St. Charles. The city hired the utility contractor for its First Street redevelopment project.

Utility work will take two to three weeks to complete. The first crew will install a water main and a second crew will install the sanitary sewer through this intersection. The schedule depends on the weather.

The intersection is closed to through traffic during the work. Customers to businesses in Fox Island Square shops at Illinois and First streets and the Blue Goose Super Market, 164 S. First, will be able to cross the bridge and access the parking areas from the east. Customers patronizing these businesses from the west side should note the detour signs and access the marked parking lots from Indiana or Prairie streets.
