First Street construction begins phase 2 today

ST. CHARLES – Work is set to begin today on phase two of the First Street construction project.

Starting this morning, the intersection of First and Indiana streets will be closed and impassable. Drivers can access the south parking lot of Fox Island Square, Aura salon, and the dry cleaner from the south end of First Street or Limestone Drive at Prairie Street. This phase is scheduled to take about a month to complete.

First Street from Prairie Street to Cobblestone will be open today as well.

The storm sewer work on Walnut Street wrapped up Tuesday, and the street is open. The street has gravel patches, so motorists are reminded to use caution and drive slowly through this area. City crews will be patching the gravel areas with asphalt. These asphalt patches will be in place until Walnut Street is reconstructed, along with the remaining First Street phases in Spring 2008.
